

Congratulations and Welcome to Oakwood University! We are glad that you have chosen 'OU' as 'YOUR' University where you will *enter to learn and depart to serve*. This summer we are offering several online courses to our new and transfer students that have been identified as needing one or more of the courses listed below based on SAT/ACT scores.

- EN 095 Composition Skills Review (2 credit hours)
- EN 099 College Reading Skills (2 credit hours)
- MA 095 Introduction to Math (2 credit hours)
- OU 097 Strategies for Academic Success (2 credit hours)

Completion of these summer courses will help students, who need to take them, stay on track. Online learning does require self discipline. These six-week courses provide the following benefits:

- Convenience and flexibility
- Significant discount on tuition
- No additional textbook purchase required for many courses (may require textbook purchase for some)
- No need to transfer courses back to OU

Classes begin on June 26 and end on August 4. If a student decides to take any of the above courses, they will need to register by the registration deadline of June 21. The last day for 100% tuition refund, less \$100 assessment fee is June 27. June 27 is also the last day to drop a course without receiving a W on your transcript. The last day to drop with a "W" on your transcript is July 21.

Summer tuition rates and fees per session are as follows:

- *1-6 Credit Hours = \$200 per credit hour (the courses available are all two credit courses). Over 6 credit hours = \$488 per additional credit hour.
- \$50 technology fee
- Mandatory book fee (where applicable)

Payments can be made by cash, credit, debit, or money order only. Payments cannot be deferred or put on next semester's accounts. All payments must be made for courses by the respective due date.

Last day for 100% tuition refund, less \$100.00 assessment fee is June 27th
6 Credit Hours = \$200 per credit hour (the courses available are all two credit courses). Over 6 credit hours = \$488

*The regular tuition rate for 1-7 credits for fall and spring semester is \$678 per credit hour.

These required courses must each be passed with a minimum grade of C before registering for other courses in English and Mathematics. The courses have a 0 prefix (example 095, 099, 097) and are mandatory courses (based on SAT/ACT test scores). These courses do not count towards the 128 credit hours that are required to graduate with a college degree from Oakwood University. We strongly encourage students who meet the criteria for these courses to complete them this summer so that they can stay on track for graduation.

THE NEXT STEP:

To register for these classes, please call (256) 726-7145 and you will be directed to an advisor who will advise you regarding the classes you need and help you register for Summer Online classes. These classes are offered online through D2L (Desire to Learn' Learning Management System). Once you have registered for your class and made the payments you will be enrolled in D2L. Once enrolled, you will receive an email from 'Brightspace by D2L' regarding logging into D2L. (The email address used will be the one you provided us during enrollment.) Use that information to log into D2L. Once in D2L, the first page on D2L will have Orientation for D2L. Please see that you go through this Orientation before starting the course. Once you have completed the Orientation you will be ready to start the class.
