

INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS & INSTRUCTIONS

PRE-ARRIVAL

Oakwood University is approved by the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency for the admission of non-immigrant students. The letter of acceptance is issued only to those students whose academic credentials are satisfactory. It is important that an international student not leave his/her country of origin until an official letter of acceptance and an I-20 A-B Form have been received. To obtain these documents, each international student must forward the following items to the Enrollment Management Department:

- If you're a Sponsor you'll need to complete the I-135 form
- Official secondary/high school transcripts and external or governmental exams*
- College/University transcript(s)*
- One letter of recommendation (if GPA is below a 2.0)
- ACT or SAT scores (College entrance exam)
- TOEFL Exam (Required for Non-English Speaking Applicants)**
- Affidavit of Support
- Surety Advance Deposit of \$1,000 for countries outside the North American Division
- Completed medical, dental and immunization forms

The I-20 A-B form is issued only after the Surety Advance Deposit and Affidavit of Support (which demonstrate the student's ability to finance an education at Oakwood University) have been received.

POST-ARRIVAL

The following items should be in the student's possession upon departure from country of origin:

- Acceptance letter from Oakwood University
- I-20 A-B form
- Affidavit of support
- **○** Valid passport
- Valid F-1 Student Visa to enter the United States
- Receipt for SEVIS fee (\$200). Pay fee at www.FMJfee.com
- Sufficient funds for tuition and living expenses

As soon as you receive your letter of acceptance to Oakwood University, your intent to enroll fee of \$200 (U.S.) should be sent directly to Student Accounts.

* If we are unable to evaluate transcripts, it will be the student's responsibility to submit transcript(s) to World Education Services (http://www.wes.org)

** The minimum acceptable score for TOEFL are as follows: 500 for written exam

173 for computer based exam 61 for the internet exam
