

## Chaperone Responsibilities:

1. Student dress should be in accordance with Oakwood University policies. The principles of modesty, simplicity, and overall neatness are a witness to our core Christian values.
2. Chaperones must remain on campus with their students throughout the day. Chaperones are responsible for always supervising your students. Please ensure they attend all scheduled meetings on time.
3. To maintain accountability of your students, they should meet you at the beginning of each day, and after each scheduled activity at a designated area of choice.
4. Know your students' room and phone numbers in case of an emergency. Chaperones must ensure that their students are in the residence halls each night, by the appointed curfew.
5. No student is allowed to go anywhere off campus without your supervision.
6. You are responsible for each student under your care. Please remember that the parents have left their children in your care, and they expected you to take care of them as they would.
7. All students must observe the curfew. No exceptions.
8. All chaperones must attend mandatory Oakwood Live orientation and reception at the Oakwood University Community Health Action Center (CHAC).
